What is a Strategic Plan?

Strategic Planning is a goal setting process in which a school district's stakeholders (board, administration, staff, parents, community-at-large, and, when age-appropriate, students) envision the future and identify the necessary steps to achieve that vision.



Why do we create a Strategic Plan?

Set direction and priorities for the district

- Define a vision and view of success
- Prioritize initiatives that drive that success

Drive alignment (get everyone on the same page)

- Focus all aspects of the operation on common outcomes and indicators
- Create a common language to resolve conflicts
- Simplify decision-making by focusing on priorities

Facilitate communication

- Create a written record which can be used in all planning efforts
- Provide an educational tool for new staff and community members
- Provide continuity through organizational change
