Harassment, Intimidation and Bullying (HIB)

Definition "Harassment, intimidation or bullying" means any gesture, any written, verbal or physical act, or any electronic communication, whether it be a single incident or a series of incidents, that is reasonably perceived as ***being motivated either by any actual or perceived characteristic, such as race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, or a mental, physical or sensory disability, or by any other distinguishing characteristic***, that takes place on school property, at any school-sponsored function [or], on a school bus, or off school grounds that substantially disrupts or interferes with the orderly operation of the school or the rights of other students
